#### Rules regarding the call for projects



- Project consortia must consist of project partners from a minimum of four countries from the two continents and include an institutional research sector partner and a commercial company
  - → More details in the call text to be published




Each partner in a selected project will be funded by the funding agency in its own country. Partners have to answer to the national eligibility criteria

- Partners from African countries that do not have a funding agency participating in LEAP-SE may be eligible under certain conditions by LGI
- Proposals must be submitted on a dematerialised platform

#### Launch of the call and evaluation





- Evaluation criteria:
  - Scientific excellence
  - Impact
  - Quality and efficiency of the implementation

#### Independent International Review Panel:

- Representation of experts working in Europe and Africa
- Gender balance
